

MUSKETEER OF HAMBLE



Introduction

Musketeer of Hamble is a fin keel Moody 376, built in 1989/90. She has been in my ownership since 1998.

Equipment

She has a 45hp Thorneycroft diesel engine and is fitted with an Autoprop self-feathering prop.

She has a full set of Simrad navigation instruments, including a GPS chart-plotter and repeater displays in the cockpit. These are all linked to the Autohelm. She has RADAR and an AIS receiver.

She has 2 holding tanks installed.

Furling main (new 2023), furling 45% overlap genoa (used once), no 2 jib, storm jib, storm main, cruising chute, full size spinnaker plus spare old mainsail and genoa.

She come with 6-man liferaft.

She comes with a 6-man Zodiac dinghy with a 2-stroke Mariner 6hp engine.

Maintenance

Musketeer has been lifted out, checked and antifouled every year. This has included servicing of the prop, replacement of sacrificial anodes. Hull polished most years.

Major recent maintenance items.

10/2025	All 3 major hatches factory refurbished.
05/2025	Engine mountings replaced, 3 new batteries
09/2025	New genoa – used only once in 2025
05/2024	All seacocks replaced. Italian bronze below waterline, DZR above waterline
2023	New main sail
2019	New fuel tank, new anemometer
2021	New genoa blocks
2013	2 holding tanks installed
2009	Rigging replaced
2005	New 'fridge
2007	Prop replaced with Autoprop
